Activities and Achievements of the Organization during the year 2023-24 :

Empowering Rural Communities : SBI Gram Seva Project

The SBI Gram Seva project has made significant strides in transforming the lives of rural communities. Our initiatives have focused on education, healthcare, livelihood, and infrastructure development, impacting over 5 adopted villages.

Education

- 505 students from financially difficult families have been provided formal education in the Goodwill Foundation School.
- Library established at N. Sabual village Primary School, benefiting 200+ students
- Remedial classes conducted in all adopted villages (i) N. Sabual (ii) Phaizau (iii) Bawngva (iv) Darlak and (v) Suarhliap, supporting 250+ students.
- Inter-school events organized, promoting sports and teamwork

- Awareness program on POCSO Act conducted, reaching 100+ students
- OJAS scholarship distributed to six deserving students, encouraging education.



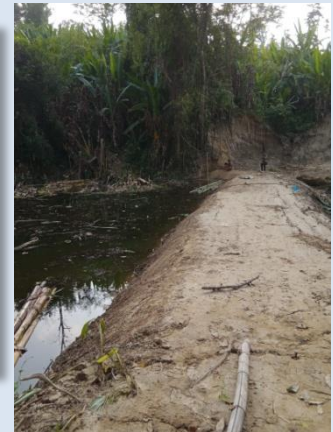
Livelihood

- Piglet distribution to 130 beneficiaries under SBI Gram Seva program and 100 beneficiaries under SBI Gram Saksham project in ten villages in Mamit district, enhancing livelihood opportunities to the farmers.
- Tailoring training conducted, empowering 50+ individuals
- Entrepreneurship Development: 7 small entrepreneurs supported, boosting daily income



Infrastructure Development

- Open Gym installed in Bawngva village, promoting community fitness.
- Check Dam constructed in Phaizau village, enhancing agriculture productivity.
- Water Cooler installed in middle and primary schools, ensuring clean drinking water.



HEALTHCARE

SBI Sanjeevani-Clinic on Wheels

SBI Sanjeevani - Clinic on Wheels has bridged the healthcare gap in rural Mizoram, demonstrating the power of collaborative efforts in transforming lives. The programme is funded by SBI Foundation to improve rural health through mobile healthcare initiative by providing primary and preventive healthcare services in 20 villages in Mamit district, Mizoram. Thousands of rural communities have benefited the clinic on wheels programme.



DISASTER RELIEF

In response to natural disasters, Goodwill Foundation swiftly swung into action, providing critical relief to affected communities. Our disaster response initiatives ensured timely supply of essential materials, including food, shelter kits, and non-food items, to those in dire need. Our team worked tirelessly to distribute relief packages, reaching some of the most vulnerable populations in affected areas. Through our food distribution programs, we provided sustenance to thousands of individuals, alleviating hunger and distress. Collaborating with local authorities and partners, we ensured efficient and effective delivery of aid, bringing hope and resilience to communities devastated by natural disasters. With financial assistance from Jumma Net, Japan, 250 families in 5 villages of Champhai district viz: Zokhawthar, Thekte, Farkawn, Khankawn and Vaphai. We provide food items, clothing and also constructed 10 rain water harvesting tanks for storing rainwater from the rooftop for domestic consumption.



HANDLOOM & HANDICRAFT TRAINING

Under the organisation’s skill development training activities Handloom and Handicraft trainings were organized and conducted for income generation activities and livelihood improvement. 170 unemployed youth have benefited the programme during the financial year 2023-24.



PIGGERY FARMING

Goodwill Foundation's Piggery Farming Project has transformed the lives of rural communities, fostering sustainable livelihoods and economic empowerment. Implemented in targeted rural areas, this initiative provides beneficiaries with female piglets, training on modern piggery practices, and ongoing veterinary support. By promoting piggery farming, we aim to enhance household income, improve food security, and create employment opportunities. To date, 230 rural families have benefited, witnessing significant increases in income and self-sufficiency.
